Our services enable contact arrangements to occur with a minimum of stress for both child/ren and parents, making it a relaxed and enjoyable experience.

United in Parenting understands the difficulties that are often experienced during and after separation and we provide parents with the opportunity to have supervised contact visits with the child/ren they do not live with.



Information and application forms can be accessed online. If you require a hard copy, please give us a call and one will be sent to you. Both parents need to complete an intake application form, and further information will be collected at the Intake Interview as part of the Intake Assessment Process.

Once forms and payment from both parties have been received, each parent is invited for separate interviews to discuss their application and their child/rens individual needs. During this time, we will go through the service agreement, and the privacy and confidentiality policy.

Both parents will be contacted once the assessment has been completed and will be advised if accepted.





United in Parenting is a full fee for service program and families accessing this service are required to fund the full cost of the service provision, payable in advance, including kilometres, reports, and interpreter services if required.

Depending on the court order or parent arrangement, the service fee(s) may be the responsibility of one parent or shared between both parents.

All supervised child / family contact visits, facilitated changeovers and transports must be paid for at least 48 hours prior to the scheduled service.

Our supervisors are always present during a supervised contact visit, and work with the non-residential parent and child/ren to build and maintain their relationship through play, sharing a meal, conversation, and positive interactions.



In some cases where either parent is not comfortable with meeting face-to-face with the other parent, a United in Parenting supervisor will facilitate or supervise the changeover.



Transportation can be an option for parents unable to facilitate this. We offer transport for:

- Facilitated changeover
- Supervised access visits

All vehicles are fitted with child restraints that comply with Australian Standards. Our vehicles are fully insured, and our supervisors abide by the Victorian Road Safety Road Rules 2017.
